The Department of Sociology of Universidad Diego Portales, in collaboration with the Centre for Intercultural and Indigenous Studies (CIIR – FONDAF), invites applications for a full-time tenure track position in sociology.

The Department of Sociology seeks candidates who demonstrate experience in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching, and a record of excellence in research in the area of intercultural and indigenous relations. Research interests in this area may include different dimensions, such as health, education, public policies, political and legal recognition processes, territorial and environmental conflicts, among many others.

About the department

The Department of Sociology at UDP is part of the Faculty of Social Sciences and History (<http://socialesehistoria.udp.cl/sociologia/>). It is a leading research-intensive department and has an outstanding reputation in teaching, ranked third in the country (América Economía 2017) and twelfth in Latin America (The Times Higher Education Ranking 2016).

Our Department is committed to the formation of new generations of sociologists with the ability to address the challenges of contemporary societies. In this context, our undergraduate and postgraduate programs provide students with an innovative approach to theoretical reflection and empirical research in a stimulating intellectual environment. The excellence of our teaching has been recognized by the Chilean National Commission for Accreditation (CNA).

Faculty develop research in areas such as: inequalities, interculturality, contemporary social theory, social conflict and cohesion, violence, family and new parental forms, energy and environment, among others. Work on these themes is developed in the context of observatories (<http://observatoriodesigualdades.icso.cl/>), nucleus (<http://www.teoriasocial.udp.cl/>; <http://www.energiaysociedad.cl>) and centers (<http://ciir.cl/>; www.coes.cl) that are led by members of our Department.

The appointment

Candidates must have a Ph.D. in Sociology or closely-related interdisciplinary field in the social sciences (Anthropology, Social Psychology, etc.) completed by the starting date of the appointment (March 2018). They are expected to contribute to strengthen the Department's teaching curriculum, academic management and research record, as well as to engage in the research activities of CIIR.

They must demonstrate experience in undergraduate and postgraduate teaching (at least three years); a record of publications in high-impact academic journals (ISI and Scopus) and the ability to attract research funding and conduct research projects with international outreach.

Candidates must demonstrate language proficiency to teach in Spanish.

Application requirements

Applicants must submit the following documentation:

- One letter of interest
- A research statement (no more than 3 pages)
- Two recent publications (from the last five years, in indexed journals or in books with blinded evaluation and an editorial committee)
- Two letters of recommendation
- A syllabus of a undergraduate course
- A syllabus of a course previously taught in postgraduate program
- Teacher assessment of courses previously taught
- A recent CV

Applications must be sent as an Adobe PDF document to the email: monica.rojas@udp.cl no later than December 29th, 2017 at 12 p.m.

The selection process comprises two phases: first, there will be a general revision of applications, and, second, there will be a series of interviews and/or presentations (in person or via some remote capacity, such as Skype). The second phase of the application process will take place during January 2018. The appointment is expected to begin in March 2018.

Academic rank and salary will be commensurate with credentials and experience.
